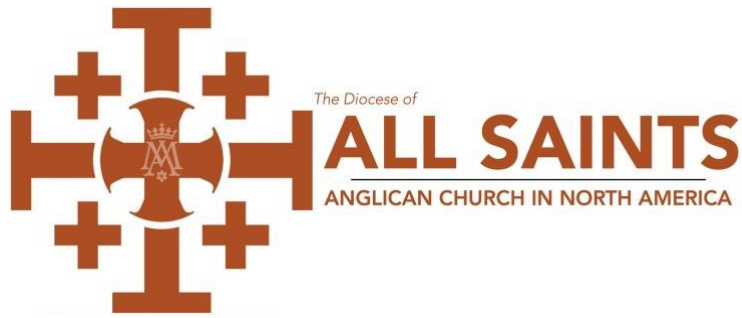




October 10, 2025 - Feast of St. Paulinus of York

The Diocese of All Saints was founded in 2009 as a missionary work commissioned by Forward in Faith North America. Our founding Bishop, the Rt. Rev. William Ilgenfritz, was the first FIFNA Bishop to be consecrated in the newly founded Anglican Church in North America. Over the years, other catholicically minded societies, dioceses, and missions have joined the Diocese of All Saints.
